- 2. The paper has not been published in any journal or presented in another scientific meeting;

3. Papers in Arabic: Written in Traditional Arabic script, size 14, and headings are bold font, size 14. Papers in foreign languages: Written in Times New Roman, size 12, and headings are bold font, size 13. Margins: 2 cm for each side. Space between lines: 1 cm;

4. references and appendices should be at the end of the paper;

5. Papers should not exceed 6 pages, including references and appendices;.

6. The first page of the paper must contain all the information about the author: full name, academic rank, university or institution working in it, e-mail, phone, paper's title, the axis of participation, and the abstract in a language other than

the language of the paper;

7. After accepting the papers, the author should shoot a video with a duration not exceeding 10 minutes in which he presents his paper, then uploads it to YouTube with a special link (not public for everyone) that he sends to the e-mail of the conference.


